ABOUT REFERENCES

- ➔ References begin on a separate page.
- ➔ Heading, centered, is typed 1 inch from top of page.
- ➔ List is alphabetized by author's last name.
- ➔ Indent on second and subsequent lines of each entry. Double space throughout.
- ➔ If no author, file citation by title.
